

Items required: Autumn 2024

FOOD

Just-add-water items are quick and easy to cook - pasta, rice, cups of soups, pasta 'n sauce, savoury rice, oats, instant mash, super noodles, etc.

Tins

Potatoes, tomatoes, macaroni cheese, ravioli, meatballs in gravy, chicken in sauce, beef stew, sardines, tuna, mackerel, minced beef and onion, stewing steak, corned beef, luncheon meat, rice pudding, custard, etc.; Breakfast bars, biscuits, chocolate, sweets, cereal, nuts, seeds, dried fruit; Tea, coffee, hot chocolate, lemon, honey, sweeteners; Bolognese sauce, pesto, beef cubes, herbs and spices, plain flour, cooking oil, tomato puree

TOILETRIES

Shower gel, soap, shampoo, toothpaste, toothbrushes, mouthwash, deodorant, dry shampoo, moisturiser, razors, shaving foam, foot powder, feminine wipes,

Hair brushes/combs/bobbles, sanitary pads/tampons, adult pads/nappies, lip balm, face wipes, flannels, towels, cotton wool, cotton buds, tissues, toilet roll/wipes and anything else you can think of.

TOOLS, etc.

Tools: any tools including power tools; Tool boxes, work benches, hammers, saws, spanners, shovels/spades, socket sets, drills/bits, nails, screws, etc.; Petrol/jerry cans (empty); Generators; Chainsaws; Fire extinguishers/blankets

WINTER WARM ITEMS

Adults/children/baby clothing: **I can't accept summer clothes due to lack of storage**.

Jumpers, cardigans, vests, coats, fleeces, pyjamas, jogging bottoms, thermals, jeans, trousers, socks, hats, scarfs, gloves/mittens, dressing gowns, Boots/trainers

BRAND NEW UNDERWEAR

Sleeping bags, quilts, blankets, ground mats/yoga mats, camp beds, tents, hot water bottles and covers; Firelighters, kindling, matches, candles,; Garden incinerators

BABIES'/TODDLERS' ITEMS

Nappies, wipes, nappy cream, formula, food, cutlery, bottles, teats, Milton, bottle brushes, dummies, baby bath, lotion, shampoo, teething gel, calpol, toothbrush/paste, moses baskets, cot bedding, clothes, blankets, sleep bags etc.; Clothes, blankets

MEDICAL SUPPLIES

First-aid kits, all types of bandages and dressings, slings, tubigrips, gauze, tourniquet, burns dressings and creams, trauma packs, sutures, butterfly/steri strips, eye wash, antiseptic cream/ointments, paracetamol, ibuprofen, cold and flu remedies, emergency blankets; Walking sticks, crutches, zimmer frames/walkers, wheel chairs/scooters, commodes.
