As Christians, praying for one another is vital. Sometimes that can be in private, sometimes with other people. Throughout the Bible we are encouraged to "carry each other's burdens" and to bring our joys, worries, hopes and fears before God. There is something deeply reassuring about knowing that someone is standing alongside you in prayer, placing your concerns into God's loving hands.

Our Prayer Ministry Team can be recognised by the blue lanyards they wear. If they're wearing a blue lanyard, they're available to pray with you. This will usually take place after you have received Holy Communion, but please feel free to approach them at any time if you see them wearing their lanyard.



If there is something weighing on your heart; a difficult decision to make, an illness, a family concern, or perhaps simply a thanksgiving you would like to share, have the confidence to approach the team. Together, you will bring it before God. It's a simple yet beautiful ministry, often a deeply personal and intimate moment, as we entrust our lives to the One who knows us better than anyone and loves us deeply.

Please also remember our Prayer Ministry Team in your own prayers. It is a privilege to share in this ministry, but also a great responsibility. Pray that God would give them wisdom, compassion and the guidance of the Holy Spirit as they serve our parish in this vital way.
